What Does It Mean to Be an ALC Member?

ALC members are adult learners and art lovers who want to connect, learn, and explore art in a flexible, community-focused space. Participation is open to all active DelArt Members with benefits that include early event registration, museum centered social meet ups, and more.

Where Can I Find Other ALC Members?

ALC members take an active role in shaping and participating in monthly, reoccurring programs like Art is Tasty, Slow Art, and DelArt Readers. Nourish your appetite for food and culture at lunchtime Art is Tasty talks on the first Friday of each month. At these gatherings, members begin by discussing a piece of artwork in our galleries and then are encouraged to continue the conversation together over lunch in Kaffeina café. During Slow Art, take a break in our galleries with a guided-looking exploration of two works of art. At these monthly meetings, members engage in the mindful practice of deep and extended reflection on a single artwork, looking closely and sharing what emerges with each other. Our art-forward book club, DelArt Readers, meets monthly to discuss, debate, celebrate, and share both works of fiction and non-fiction. Selections focus on art, artists, and/or the artistic process broadly or in response to DelArt's collection and special exhibits. Looking for other ways to connect? Seasonal bus trips and special gallery talks and lectures help expand your art connections.
