Rebecca "Little Turtle Who Sees" Jackson-Square has been creating art since age seven, using mixed media for storytelling and self-discovery. A proud Two-Spirit Indigenous artist and published poet, her work reflects reconnection, resilience, and reclamation. Adopted out of her tribe in the late 1970s, she reunited with her birth family two years ago and re-grounded with the Nanticoke Tribe of Millsboro, Delaware.

For over a decade, Rebecca has taught community and youth arts. Her work, inspired by East Coast Powwows and relationships with nature and spirits, embodies Indigenous rights and adoption themes. An experienced educator with over 25 years in community work, she uses art as a bridge between tradition and transformation, honoring ancestors through creative expression.
